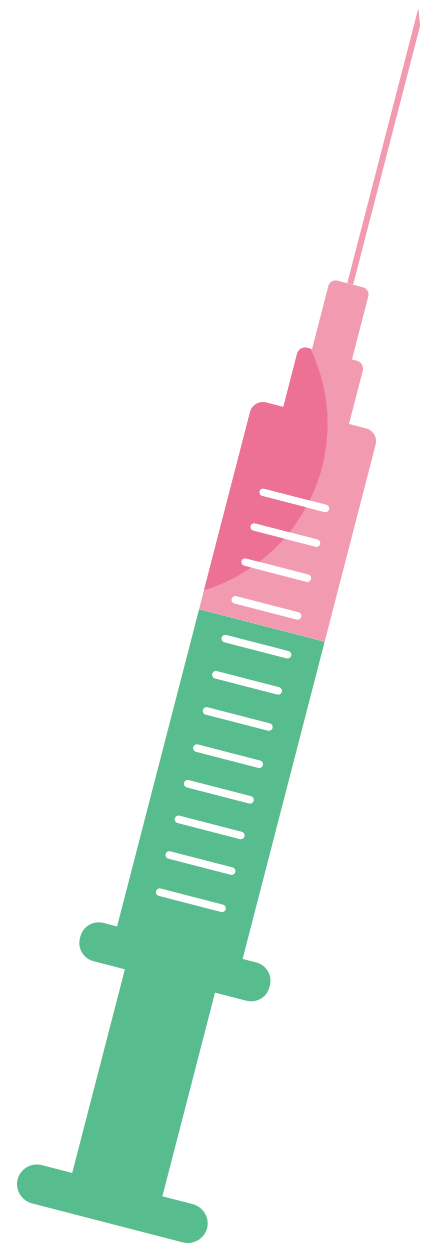


# Did you receive a Sisonke vaccination?

Booster shots of Janssen<sup>®</sup> (J&J) will be available from selected vaccination sites from

**Tuesday 9 November.\***



\*Sites have to complete an accreditation process involving local ethics approvals and training before they can offer Sisonke booster doses.

# You **CAN** get a booster shot if:



You received a first dose of J&J through the Sisonke study.



Even if you are pregnant or breastfeeding.

# You **CANNOT** get a booster shot if:



Your first dose of J&J was received outside the Sisonke study.



You have already accessed a booster vaccination through other means.

# BEFORE vaccination



Look out for your SMS invitation which contains a link to the online consent form.



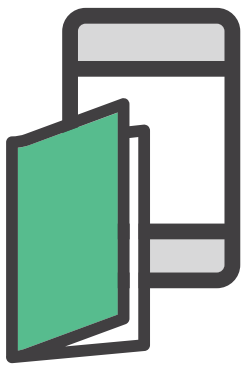
Please read the consent form carefully. If you wish to participate, please complete it.

**Please DO NOT re-register on EVDS.**

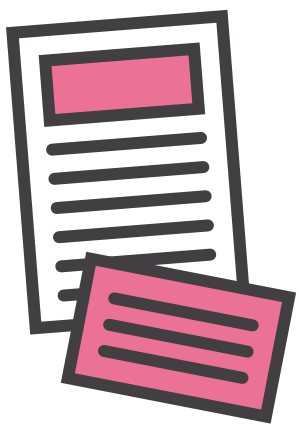
# ON THE DAY of vaccination



Bring your ID/ passport and voucher number to the site.



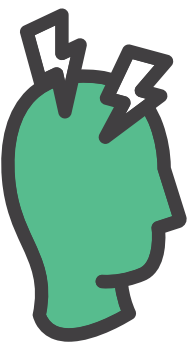
You will receive a full dose of Janssen<sup>®</sup> (J&J).



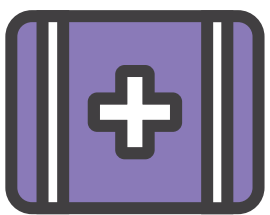
You will receive a new vaccine card and an information leaflet to take home.

# **AFTER** vaccination



Usual side-effects are less severe after the second dose.

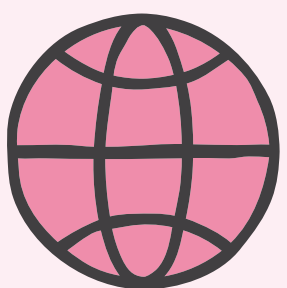
